Introduction

As a pastor of over 20 years, I have struggled with all of the issues of pastoral ministry, including a passion to grow a slow-growing church. I began my first pastorate with a crowd of 17 people. After almost ten years of hard labor the church had grown to a comfortable 350 in weekend attendance. I spent those years, like most pastors, trying to figure out how to advance and grow the church. I devoured countless church growth books and attended conferences from one end of the country to the other. Eventually a pattern began to emerge that affected the way that I viewed and conducted ministry. This led to an *explosive period of church growth* over the next four years where our church grew to over 1200.

I came to understand that the ministries of the church were essentially delivery systems of varying effectiveness. I realized that a large part of being a pastor meant that I was responsible to develop or empower people around me to develop effective services and connection mechanisms that delivered authentic life-changing ministry to people. The biblical mandate for this is found in Ephesians 4:12 where the job of the pastor is defined as "equipping" Christians so that they can do the work of the ministry. Equipping includes everything from new ministry development, to vision casting, to recruiting, to training and to releasing people into ministry. This is the unique function of the pastor. I, and my pastoral staff, needed to become experts at facilitating the development and design of effective ministry systems.

The more I contemplated my role as a pastor the more I came to realize that there was a disconnect between our ministries and the

people they were designed to serve. Many of the neWelcome Calleromers to our church were not finding their way into the venues that were specifically designed to provide opportunities to build new relationships. Nor were many visitors, even those with proven ministry backgrounds in other churches, being connected into opportunities for service. Yet, every church growth expert and writer over the past 20 years had distilled the keys of visitor assimilation down to the two central components of relationships and involvement. While our church offered many circles of belonging for neWelcome Calleromers, and had a streamlined path to easy ministry involvement, we needed something more.

I knew by looking at our church that we did not need another ministry. We needed a mechanism, a ministry behind our ministries, which would effectively connect our visitors into our existing ministries and into pathways of service. It was around this time that the simple thought hit me that visitors represented

100% of our church's growth potential. As silly as it sounds, I needed to crystallize this basic thought before I could begin acting and conducting ministry, like I believed it. It struck me that we were far too passive in our mindset towards visitors. We would need to be more proactive than listing our ministries in the church

bulletin with the mindset, "whosoever will may come." We needed a paradigm shift that said, "We are going into the highways and byways to bring them in."

This was the beginning of what has become ConnectionPower.com™ Ministries. We entered into a season of brainstorming and system development that utilized the best of proven research. We launched Connection Ministries and discovered that there were all kinds of people in the church who resonated with this as a critical need of the church and who were thrilled to join the team. These participants were called Connection Partners. The impact of Connection Ministries outstripped our expectations. Not only did we see an immediate rise in our ability to connect people into the church, but also we saw a subtle yet important shift in the hearts of our people towards an outward focused vision. This resulted in significant church growth.

The Assemblies of God Home Missions Department later adopted Connection Ministries along with some other ministry systems, which I had developed and published in The Pastor's Journal, as a part of a national pastor mentoring and training ministry called Project Hope. I found myself conducting pastoral seminars across the country while actively pastoring a growing church. This was a rich and invaluable experience. Many pastors reported that their churches had begun to grow after years of being on a plateau. Lots of lessons were learned from several years of field implementation and the invaluable feedback from pastors around the country.

The greatest challenge of The Pastor's Journal version of the Visitor Tracking and Touching System was getting all those paper copies of Visitor Report Forms back from those who were calling visitors so the visitor files could be updated and more calls could be assigned. This was a constant logistical challenge requiring a huge commitment of human resources and, at times, no small amount of frustration.

After years of implementation and the discovery of many best practices, I realized

that emerging Internet technology could be utilized to leverage the Visitor Tracking and Touching System into a powerful new ministry for the church. ConnectionPower™ is a 100% web-based software application that has totally solved the problem of the paper-based system. Connection Partners are instantly emailed assignments and can enter their call results on visitors from the comfort of their home on their own computer. Their call results are instantaneously updated into the visitor database, via the Internet. Staff can view a real-time visitor's status from any location at any time and reassign further Connection Partner calls.

One final huge surprise awaited us with the implementation of a web-based ministry. The information that our Connection Partners were collecting from their visitor calls were being automatically stored into a database that we could query in various ways. It soon became apparent, that a by-product of Connection Ministries was that we could generate reports that displayed information that was previously unavailable to any pastor. Suddenly, I could see, in graph form, the leading indicators of my church's growth. At a glance I could see our visitor volume rates, our visitor retention rates and our back door rates over the past year. Emerging trends leapt off the page.



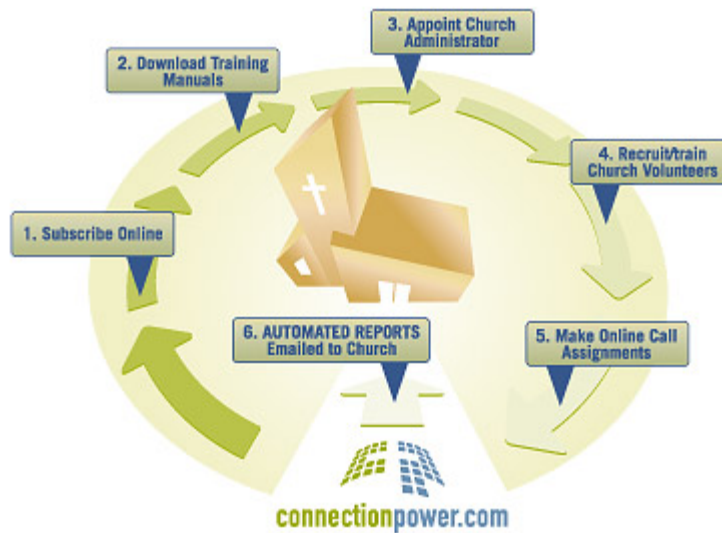
